All-State Post Basic Requirements

Posts achieving All-State basic requirements will be awarded All-State status. The deadline for accomplishing the above requirements is May 1, 2021.

The First 1-9 are picked by the Department Commander, 9 is a national requirement.

- 1. Post must achieve 100% in membership by end of membership year
- 2. Recruit new and reinstated members equal to 1.01 % of prior year total
- 3. Post holds 1 outreach event in each half of the fiscal year. (Need a picture or report within 7 days of event to state HQs).
- 4. Post Commander, Quartermaster and Adjutant must attend school of instruction.
- 5. Post purchases 1,000 poppies by May 1, 2021
- 6. Post makes a \$275 donation to State Headquarters for VFW Programs no later than May 1, 2021
- 7. Post submit a community service log to the District Commander for judging by April 16, 2021
- Post submits one Patriot Pen and one Voice of Democracy
- 9. Post must be in good standing in accordance with the National By- Laws

All-State Basic District Requirements

Districts achieving All-State Basic requirements will be awarded All-State status the deadline for accomplishing the above requirements is May 1, 2021

The First 1-8 are decided by the Department Commander, 8 falls under national requirements.

- 1. District must achieve 100% in membership by end of membership year
- 2. Recruit new and reinstated members equal to 1.01 % of prior year total
- 3. District holds 1 recruiting event in conjunction with the membership round up
- 4. Post inspections must be completed and submitted by November 30, 2020; Discrepancies followed up with no Later the Mid-Winter Conf.
- 5. District forwards one Voice of Democracy and one Patriot Pen entry for state judging
- 6. District Commander attends all Council of Administration meeting
- 7. District Commander, Quartermaster, and Adjutant attends a School of Instruction
- 8. District must be in good standing in accordance with the National By- Laws

Recognition

All State Post

All Posts having met basic All-State requirements as determined by May 1, 2021 will be designated as an All-State Post

Awards for the All-State Post

- 1. An official All-State Team Commanders Cap (for first time awardees only)
- 2. An All-State lapel pin with year bar
- 3. Commanders coin
- 4. Certificate of Achievement

Post of the Year

The highest scoring Post in each category will be named Post of the Year and will receive an appropriate plaque. *All-State will receive first consideration even if they are lower in points.

All State Team Captain

The highest scoring All-State Team Post Commander will be named All-State Team Captain and will receive an appropriately embroidered cap and special plaque for their post. Only one (1) Team Captain will be awarded

Awards for the Post of the Year by Category

- 1. An official All-State Team Commanders Cap (for first time awardees only)
- 2. An All-State lapel pin with year bar
- 3. Commanders coin
- 4. Post of the Year Plaque
- 5. Metal All-State Post Sign for the year to display in your community.

Dual Awards

In the event a District Commander also serves as a Post Commander and achieves All-State in both positions, both caps will be provided (so long as it is the first award)

Recruiting Awards

For every 5 new or reinstated members one recruits or recovers, their name will be placed in a drawing and the winner will be rewarded with:

- Upgrade to Life member if a continuous member
- Upgrade to Bronze Legacy Life member if already a Life member
- One-level Legacy Life upgrade if already Bronze or Silver Legacy Life
- \$400 if already a Gold Legacy Life member

 The drawing will be held at the State Convention

State Convention Awards

- The District Commander reporting the highest percentage in membership equaling or exceeding 101 % by May 1, 2021 will receive a Commander's coin and portfolio at the State Convention.
- The Post Commander in each of the five (5) Post Categories reporting the Highest Percentage in membership equaling or exceeding 100% by May 1, 2021 will receive a Commander's coin and portfolio at the State Convention.
- The Post and Auxiliary in each category who orders the most Buddy Poppies as of May 1, 2021 will be presented a plaque at the District Convention.
- All-State Post Recognition
- All National Recognition

All awards will be based on membership statistics obtained from VFW National Headquarters.

- All posts attaining 100% in membership will receive a Certificate of Achievement
- Runner up presentation in Community Service
- Any District Award
- All awards not presented at the state convention
