3. <u>HQS OFFICE PHONE NUMBERS AND EMAIL ADDRESSES</u>: At the conclusion of the State Convention we will be transitioning from Frontier phone and internet to T-Mobile phone and internet. The new office primary number is 304-310-0407 and secondary 304-395-2430. The new email address is <u>vfwwvqm@gmail.com</u>.

4. <u>CONVENTION REGISTRATION AND HOTEL INFORMATION</u>: There is no registration cost to attend the State Convention. There is a \$20 cost to attend the Saturday evening banquet. The registration form is included with these General Orders. We ask those to provide a registration form even though you may not be attending the banquet. Banquet tickets will be available at the same cost at the Convention.

5. <u>POST ARREARAGES, DEFICIENCIES AND OMISSIONS</u>: District Commanders are notified nearly each week of Posts in arrears. If you are unsure whether you are in arrears contact your District Commander. Post in arrears shall be deprived of all representation in District meetings, District, Department and National Conventions. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies.

6. **<u>DISTRICT ARREARAGES, DEFICIENCIES AND OMISSIONS</u>**: Per Section 413 of the National Bylaws, the **Commander of the District in arrears shall be deprived of all representation at the Department Convention**. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies. A properly completed District Election Report shall be submitted to National Headquarters prior to the convening of the Department Convention.

7. <u>STATE AND DISTRICT CONVENTOIN DELEGATES</u>: Posts are required to send their Delegate list to the District and State Quartermaster by June 5th. A call for Delegate list and fees has been sent to each Post. In accordance with Section 222 of the National Manual of Procedure, Post delegates and alternates to the District Convention and meetings, Department and National Convention shall be elected at a regular meeting in April. Posts are entitled to one delegate for every 30 members in good standing or fraction thereof as of March 31st. In accordance with Section 521 of the National Bylaws, a Post member must be registered as a delegate and be present at the District and/or Department Convention to cast the delegate strength of the Post when voting.

8. <u>**RESOLUTIONS AND BYLAWS CHANGES**</u>: Posts must submit any resolutions and proposed changes to the State and National Bylaws, National Manual of Procedure and Ritual to State HQS by June 1st for consolidation to provide to the Bylaws and Resolutions Committee. How to properly submit a resolution can be found at <u>https://vfwwv.com/di/vfw/v2/default.asp?pid=60863</u>.

9. <u>2025-2026 OFFICERS</u>: As a reminder, Post and District officers appointed and elected for the 2025-2026 year shall not take charge until the conclusion of the State Convention. Additionally, Posts are to elect delegates for the 2025-2026 year.
