5. **DISTRICT ARREARAGES, DEFICIENCIES AND OMISSIONS:** Per Section 413 of the National Bylaws, the **Commander of the District in arrears** for financial obligations to Department or National for fees, dues, poppy money, supply money, or failing to have the office of the Quartermaster properly bonded in accordance with Section 703, failing to ensure that the District is properly insured in accordance with Section 709, failing to submit properly completed District Trustees Report of Audit, District Election Report for the ensuing year, or other obligations, **shall be deprived of all representation at the Department Convention.** Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies. A properly completed District Election Report shall be submitted to National Headquarters prior to the convening of the Department Convention.

7. **STATE AND DISTRICT CONVENTION DELEGATES:** Posts are required to send their Delegate list to the District and State Quartermaster by June 5th. A call for Delegate list and fees has been sent to each Post. In accordance with Section 222 of the National Manual of Procedure, Post delegates and alternates to the District Convention and meetings, Department and National Convention shall be elected at a regular meeting in April. Posts are entitled to one delegate for every 30 members in good standing or fraction thereof as of March 31<sup>st</sup>. In accordance with Section 521 of the National Bylaws, a Post member must be registered as a delegate and be present at the District and/or Department Convention to cast the delegate strength of the Post when voting.

8. **RESOLUTIONS AND BYLAWS CHANGES**: Posts must submit any resolutions and proposed changes to the State and National Bylaws, National Manual of Procedure and Ritual to State HQS by June 1<sup>st</sup> for consolidation to provide to the Bylaws and Resolutions Committee.
