- 4. **SCOUT OF THE YEAR:** Congratulations to Benjamin Woodard of Troop 62, Huntington, WV for winning the Department Scout of the Year. Benjamin was sponsored by Post 1064 Huntington.
- 5. **POST COMMANDERS:** Your attention is directed to Section 218(a)(1)k, assure that the **Commander or their representative** attend all properly called District Conventions or meetings. The District Conventions are scheduled for May 4th and 5th as indicated on page 1.
- 6. **POST QUARTERMASTERS:** Section 211 of the national Bylaws stipulates authority to the Commander-in-Chief, to suspend and eventually revoke a Post Charter for failure to submit a properly completed Post Election Report by June 1. Additionally, Section 222 of the National Bylaws requires each Post to pay in advance a National Convention registration fee of \$25.
- 7. **VFW YOUTH CAMP:** With these General Orders is a request for a donation of \$100 for your Post and/or Auxiliary (if applicable) on the back of the T-shirts given to the kids attending youth camp. The proceeds will significantly help with paying for camper awards and other camp expenses. Posts and Auxiliaries can also bring items listed to the State Convention.

PAST NATIONAL COMMANDER RICH HOMAN MEMORIAL AWARD: This award will be presented to an outstanding VFW member who is a member in good standing in a Post in West Virginia, based on his or her community service involvement promoting the objectives and values of the VFW in the community.
